Following on the success of this class last year, the AFYM are encouraging performers again to bring their own compositions and perform them to an audience. It can be a solo, duet or ensemble performed by the composer and partner/s. This is a non-competitive Class.

CLASS CO2: WOMEN COMPOSERS

This class was introduced in 2023 and was met with great enthusiasm. The exam syllabi, conservatoires as well as public broadcasting such as BBC3, are also introducing such music that has been hidden away over past centuries. AFYM continues this year to support tis process of presenting these great works to a modernday audience. Performers are encouraged to say a little about the composers before they play.

This class is open to any performer and can be played on any instrument. The performance can be solo, duet or ensemble. When entering this class, entrants need to state the approximate grade of the piece being performed and the instrument/s to be played. This is non competitive class.

CLASS M01C: UNACCOMPANIED BACH MINIMUM STANDARD GRADE 6

FEE £6.50

Own choice of **one** piece of music by J S Bach for any instrument, to be played unaccompanied. Credit will be given for authenticity of Baroque performance.

Time Limit: 5 minutes

CLASS MO3N: BRITISH MUSIC MINIMUM STANDARD GRADE 5 FEE £6.50

Own choice of **one** piece by a British composer. Open to all instruments.

Time Limit: 5 minutes

CLASS M04C: CONCERTO AGE 20 YEARS AND UNDER

FEE £9.50

Any one movement from a Concerto for any instrument, excluding piano. (Unfortunately there will not be two pianos available in the same room.)

The orchestral part is to be included, to be played on piano. Double concertos may be performed in this class. Please use a group name when entering.

Any **one** piece for two performers, playing the same or different instruments, inclusive of all instruments. Neither player to have passed a Grade 6 examination of any examining board.

CLASS M08C: SENIOR DUETS GRADE 6 AND ABOVE FEE £6.50

Any **one** piece for two performers, playing the same or different instruments, inclusive of all instruments.

Any **one** piece for 3 to 6 performers on any instrument, without conductor.

PAM WEDGWOOD SYLLABUS

These classes will be adjudicated by Pam Wedgwood

CLASS PW1: 11 YEARS AND UNDER

FEE £6.00

Open to any performer up to and including age 11 years. Own choice of **one** piece, solo, duet or ensemble, on any instrument, written by Pam Wedgwood.

CLASS PW2: 12 - 18 FEE £7.00

Open to any performer up to and including age 12 to 18 years. Own choice of **one** piece, solo, duet or ensemble, on any instrument, written by Pam Wedgwood.

CLASS PW3: 18 and over FEE £10.00

Open to any adult performers. Own choice of **one** piece, solo, duet or ensemble, on any instrument, written by Pam Wedgwood.

CLASS PW4: PIANO INTERPRETATION FEE £7.00

This follows on from the success of this class in last year's on-line Festival. The AFYM will commission Pam Wedgwood to compose a new piano piece of around grade 3/4 standard. It will have no title, no indication of tempo, dynamics, phrasing, or expression. Performers will have to decide these things themselves. The piece will be available on the AFYM website. You will be directed there once you have registered, and once Pam has written it.

In their video recording performers are asked to name the title and say what inspired them to select this title and interpretation. Pam will choose the title and interpretation that she feels most suits the piece. This is an opportunity to be really musical and creative and to take part in an exciting challenge.

NEW CLASSES SYLLABUS

The AFYM are pleased to introduce two new classes which include electronic instruments, and the use of technology. As music production is becoming one of the most important factors in the music industry and the economy as a whole, the AFYM wish to embrace this trend by providing the opportunity for performers to present their music using electronic instruments and modern music production methods.

CLASS N1: ROCK and POP Solos or Bands FEE £7.00

Open to any performer or performers under and including 18 years. Own choice of **one** piece, solo, duet or ensemble, on any instrument, including electronic instruments and drum kits.

Time Limit: 3 minutes

CLASS N2: SOUND and VIDEO FEE £7.00

Open to any performer or performers under and including 18 years. Performers need to create their own composition, using any instrument, including acoustic and electronic instruments, music technology, drum kits and anything else required! The performance needs to accompany a 2-minute video or photo collages to do with the most pressing topic of CLIMATE CHANGE. The performer will need to prepare the video material themselves and then compose the soundtrack to accompany it.

We are very excited by this new class. It is a great opportunity to accept a creative challenge and learn or practice skills that are becoming more and more necessary in an ever changing and fast-growing technological musical world.
